

The **grades** are obtained from **combining** midterm exams, final exams, computer laboratories, continuous tests, projects and reports, accordingly to a distinct formula for **each course**.

*(consult the MCC file online)*

- The minimum **threshold** for **each grade**, to validate the whole Master 1 (allow the compensation process: see below), is **7/20**.
- **All grades below 10/20 can be compensated by better ones:**
- The grade for **a semester** is the **mean** of all teaching module grades **weighted** by their respective **ECTS** number. Such a mean higher than **10/20** allows to validate the semester.
- **M1 = 2 x 30 ECTS** required for the **2 Semesters**.

- An organised **second session** can also be proposed in case:
  - of **absence** at a 1st session exam

*(an absence justification document appears on the grade transcript ; the grade can exceptionally be counted as a first session grade)*

- of a grade **below the threshold** of **7/20**
- of **no compensation** [semester mean **below 10/20**]
- of **compensation refusal** written by the student  
[in order **to improve** the grades]

*(\* undergo a new examination for each grade below 10*

*\* risk : second session grades kept as final grades).*
